

COVID-19 GUIDANCE FOR SECURITY OFFICERS



This is the best information we have as of March 6, 2020. The situation is evolving and information, including guidelines are subject to change.

- Workers may be asked to deliver food or other supplies to infected residents, in such cases the workers should leave the materials outside the infected persons door and maintain standard hand hygiene practices.
- If requested to guard a quarantine room, officers should remain outside the room unless they are provided with enhanced PPE and training on how to don, doff and dispose of such materials. **See additional for more information about enhanced PPE.**
- If asked to respond to an individual who is ill with suspected COVID-19, officers should remain at least three (WHO guidance) to six (CDC guidance) feet away, and relay all information to health care providers or first responders.
- Workers should maintain a social distance of at least three (WHO guidance) to six (CDC guidance) feet from all individuals who are suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19, or who appear to have respiratory symptoms.

All Local 32BJ workers should follow general guidance for how to stay healthy and limit the spread of germs, including frequent hand washing.
